The more diverse your working group the more innovative ideas!



















Journey to Belonging – Choice & Inclusion Principles


- Services build on the strengths of people & supports provided by families, support networks & communities.
 - Supports complement services available in community
 - Supports are culturally appropriate, & reflect regional differences in ON
- Supports are person-directed & flexible
 - People have <u>more control over directing & managing their funding & supports</u>




Journey to Belonging – Choice & Inclusion Principles

- Services are driven by evidence, outcomes, and continuous improvement
 - More emphasis on outcomes & quality services that are responsive to feedback from people using them.
- Services and supports promote health, well-being, and safety.
 - Services help address systemic barriers (discrimination, ableism) that prevent people from accessing and fully participating in their communities.
