






In 2006, Mercer Delta Consulting, identified that after young people reached age 21 their families often referred to encountering "the cliff", a term coined to describe the dramatic decrease in the level of services available despite the ongoing support needs that an individual with DD required. Mercer Delta reported that this decrease in supports often produced a rapid decrease in much of the progress made toward developing the individual's independence and quality of life as many youths were left at home with "nothing to do" (McKay 2019).
